Funeral of Mrs. Bagger

The funeral of Mrs. Gertrude Elizabeth Bagger, the wife of Mr. Louis Bagger, the Danish vice consul in this city, concurred Tuesday afternoon from her late residence, No. 117, C street northeast. The services were conducted by Rev. Dr. Corey of the Metropolitan M.E. Church. The remains were borne to the grave by Messrs. Chauncey A. Snow, W.L. Woods, W.H.B. Kittson, August Peterson, Prof. Christiana and H.L. West, and were followed by a large concourse of mourners, among whom the Danish legation was represented.
