## Kills Self by Inhaling Gas in 9th Street Home

Mrs. Mary A. Barker, forty-seven years old, committed suicide by inhaling illuminating gas in her home, 529 9th street southwest, yesterday afternoon, according to a certificate issued by Coroner Nevitt.

Mrs. Barker has been ill for some time, the coroner was told. Yesterday afternoon she entered a front room of her home and locked the door. Her husband forced an entrance later and discovered the room filled with gas, which was escaping from an open jet.
