Capt. Robert Barron

Barron. On Monday the 23rd inst. at Mr. Buller Cocke's in this city, Captain Robert Barron, an old and respectable inhabitant of Norfolk, in Virginia. He had long labored under a painful and debilitating complaint which nothing could cure. He met his fate with a manly fortitude, and resigned his last breath with the pious resignation of a Christian. A few days would have completed the 5th month of his 64th year.

Captain Barron was remarkable for a correctness, probity and integrity of conduct, and was at the time of his death the senior master of a vessel belonging to Norfolk. He had long occupied a place under the collector of that port and was universally beloved by those who knew him.
