The Funeral of Mrs. Harriet Bayne, widow of the late John Bayne, took place from her late residence, No. 406 Virginia avenue southeast, yesterday evening, and was largely attended. The remains were placed in an elegant coffin, covered with black cloth, with heavy silver mountings. The funeral services were conducted by the pastor of the Second Baptist church, corner 4th street and Virginia avenue southeast; after which the remains were conveyed to the Congressional cemetery and interred in the family lot. She was loved by all who knew her, and her demise will be deeply regretted, especially by the poor of that vicinity, who on application to her for relief were never sent away empty-handed.
