## Liselotte von Usedom Beach

## **Research Analyst**

Liselotte von Usedom Beach, 82, who retired in 1975 after 31 years as a research assistant at the Carnegie Institute of Washington, died of cancer February 26 at her home in Chevy Chase. She had lived in the Washington area since 1940.

Mrs. Beach analyzed data in the fields of magnetism, atmospheric electricity, cosmic rays and seismology with the department of terrestrial magnetism at the Carnegie Institute. She was coauthor of two volumes of "Cosmic Ray Results" and of several articles.

A native of Berlin, Mrs. Beach emigrated to this country in 1925. She was a graduate of Stanford University.

She was a volunteer with the Prevention of Blindness Society of Metropolitan Washington and received its community service award in 1990.

Her husband, Dr. W. Edwards Beach, died in 1956.

Survivors include three sons, Arthur J. Beach of Columbus, Ohio, and Allen E. Beach and Walter E. Beach, both of Chevy Chase; and seven grandchildren.
