Woman of Distinguished Ancestry Succumbs to Short Illness

Mrs. Katherine Carroll Beale, widow of John Wheeler Beale, died yesterday after a short illness at her residence in the Dresden Apartments. Funeral services will be held there at 2 p.m. tomorrow. Burial will be private.

Mrs. Beale was the daughter of the late Maj. Gen. Samuel Sprigg Carroll, U.S.A., and the late Helen Bennett Carroll of St. Louis. She was a direct descendant of the first Charles Carroll, who settled in Maryland; a relative of Charles Carroll of Carrollton, signer of the Declaration of Independence, and of Daniel Carroll of Duddington, a signer of the Constitution. Through her paternal grandmother she was directly descended from Gov. Sprigg of Maryland,. Daniel Carroll of Carrollsburg was another ancestor.
