Will of Sarah Beall, of Washington, D.C., wife of John H. Beall (dtd. May 16, 1823, probated June 3, 1823)

My late relation, Dr. William Potts, of Fredericktown, Md., by his last will and testament gave legacy to my children for their support and advancement and whereas my youngest daughter, Ann Lee Beall, not having been born before the devise cannot be a partaker with her sisters and brothers; being anxious that she should be equal in point of fortune, I give to Ann Lee Beall, all the land which I hold in Calvert Co., Md. and which descended to me as one of the heirs of Rebecca Mackall, deceased; also to my daughter Ann Lee Beall, the interest arising from a legacy to me from the late Elizabeth C. Potts, for as long a time as I might have received the same.
