

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Addie Bishop; a sister, Mrs. Clara V. Smoot and a brother, Charles W. Bishop.

Funeral services will be conducted in St. Dominic's Catholic Church Wednesday morning at 9 o'clock. Interment will be in the family plot in Congressional Cemetery.
