Louis G. Bouscaren, 73, Retired U.S. Employee

Louis G. Bouscaren, 73, who worked 43 years for the Government before he retired in 1945, died Wednesday at his home in South Haven, Annapolis, Md. He had lived there for the last nine years.

Born in Chattanooga, Tenn., Mr. Bouscaren came to Washington as a boy. He went to Georgetown Preparatory School and Georgetown University. He worked several years in the District surveyor's office before he began employment with the old Shipping Board. He was a valuation engineer with the Maritime Commission when he retired.
