B. Agee Bowles, 77, a retired banker and real estate broker, died of cancer yesterday at Suburban Hospital. Mr. Bowles, of 4605 Hunt ave., Bethesda, began his career in banking more than 50 years ago as a runner for the old Potomac Savings Bank located in Georgetown. Later he became executive vice president of the bank, a post he held until 1933.
