On Thursday, R. Stratton Bradford, of this city, a private in Capt. Clarke's Company, First District Volunteers, in getting ashore from a vessel lying at the wharf at Alexandria, missed his footing, fell overboard and was drowned. His body was recovered about half an hour after the occurrence, and will be interred today.
