Frederick Briggs, 74, Retired Packer, Dies

Frederick Briggs, 74 of 5825 Sixteenth street N.W., for many years a prominent figure in local and national meat packing business circles, died at his home today after a long illness.

A native of Kansas, Mr. Briggs came to the District 60 years ago and entered the meat-packing business. He soon went into business for himself, forming the present L.S. Briggs Co. some years ago. He retired from active work about seven years ago. He was a member of Washington Centennial Lodge of Masons.

Mr. Briggs is survived by his widow, Mrs. Annie E. Briggs; three sons, Raymond C., Luther S. and Lester F. Briggs, and two daughters, Mrs. Thelma Goodman and Mrs. Anita Dunn all of Washington.
