Death of Rev. Stephen Brown

Rev. Stephen Brown died yesterday of heart failure at his residence, 930 B street southwest. He was in the eighty-fourth year of his age and had not been in active service of late years. He was born in Westmoreland, N.H., and was a traveling minister in the Genesee conference, New York, for twenty-two years. Since the year 1873 he has been a resident of this city. His widow, a son, S.C. Brown, registrar of the Smithsonian Institute, and a married daughter, who lives in Rochester, N.Y., survive him.
