Arthur Brummitt Dies

Arthur Brummitt, assistant master mechanic in the gunshop of the Washington navy yard for about twenty years, died at George Washington University Hospital yesterday. Mr. Brummitt was born in Leeds, England, and came to this country about thirty years ago. He was an acknowledged ordnance expert.

He had long been a member of the Masonic order, and his funeral will be conducted by St. John's Lodge No. 11, from the family residence, 618 C street northeast. Besides his wife, he leaves a daughter, Miss Carrie Brummitt, a recent graduate of the Washington Normal School and now a teacher in Virginia.
