Zouaves Killed

Another shooting case occurred in the afternoon. A private of the same corps (New York Zoaves), named Buckley, a member of the firm of Allen, McLean and Buckley, was killed by an officer. Deceased was under confinement at the time, and determined to pass the bounds assigned him, when, during the resistance, he met his untimely fate. He will probably be buried in Alexandria.
