Civil War Veteran, Who Was in Treasury Department Many Years, Heart Attack Victim

Daniel N. Burbank, 86 years old, a Civil War veteran and retired Government employe, died suddenly yesterday at his home, 2147 F street, following a heart attack

A native of New York State, Mr. Burbank enlisted in the Union Army at the outbreak of the Civil War, serving with the 112th New York Infantry.

Following the war, he entered the Government service in Washington, where he has resided continuously for more than 50 years. At the time of his retirement he was chief of the foreign division in the sixth auditor's office of the Treasury Department.

Besides his widow, he is survived by a son, Dr. Caryl Burbank, and a daughter, Miss Maud Burbank, a teacher in the District schools. Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 2 p.m. at Hysong's funeral parlors, Thirteenth and N streets. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
