Death of a Soldier

William T. Campbell of Seventh Illinois Victim of Accident

William T. Campbell, the teamster of the 7th Illinois Volunteers who was injured by striking his head against one of the trolley poles on the Falls Church electric road last week died at the Emergency Hospital about 5 o'clock yesterday. Campbell was a passenger on one of the cars, and it is said while leaning out was knocked off. He was afterward brought to the hospital. Coroner Carr found that his skull had been fractured. He gave a certificate of accidental death. The body was turned over to friends for burial.
