E.J. Cantwell, Sr., Dies

Confederate Veteran, 87, Was Wounded in Battle of Manassas

Enoch James Cantwell, sr., 87 years old, Confederate veteran and for many years an employe of the Pennsylvania Railroad, died at his residence, 1106 Maryland avenue southwest yesterday, after a short illness.

Mr. Cantwell came to this city before the Civil War, but at the outbreak of the conflict went to Virginia to enlist in the Confederate Army. He was wounded in the battle of Manassas and later went to work for the railroad then being operated by the Federal Government between Washington and Philadelphia. He afterward worked as a foreman for the Pennsylvania Railroad until retired about 16 years ago.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Sarah A. Cantwell, and two sons, Enoch J. Cantwell, jr., and G.B. Cantwell, all of this city.

Federal services will be conducted at the residence Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
