At her residence, near Baltimore, on Sabbath morning, the 22d instant, in the 77th year of her age, Mrs. Elizabeth Clark, widow of Mr. Francis Clark, deceased formerly of this city. Mrs. C. was a native of the county Antrim, Ireland; but for many years had been a valuable and respected member of our community, before her removal to Baltimore. Her death will be keenly felt by her bereaved family, and deeply mourned by many friends; but we trust she has exchanged this world for one infinitely better.

Her funeral will take place from Dr. Laurie's church, F street, on Thursday next, (tomorrow) at 12 o'clock M. The friends of the family are respectfully invited to attend without further notice.

To three daughters: Frances, Elizabeth and Letitia, to be divided among them as they may mutually agree, residue of estate; including all debts or sums of money which may be due arising from rents or otherwise, in right of my dower in the estate of my late husband, Francis Clark.
