Death Delays Steamer

Sailing of the steamer Calvert from the foot of L street southwest yesterday afternoon was delayed because of the death of William D. Cline, a passenger, who died just before the hour the steamer was scheduled to start on its trip to Baltimore.

Cline, forty years old, resided at 116 D street northwest. He was on his way to visit relatives at Pomonkey, Charles county, Md. Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of death from natural causes.
