Deaths of Old and Well Known Citizens

Mr. John L. Clubb, an old citizen of the District, died at his residence on I street, between 6th and 7th, about one o'clock this morning, of typhoid pneumonia, in the 70th year of his age. Mr. Clubb was a native of Maine, but came to this District when a boy and for many years was a member of the Marine band. Subsequently he was a clerk for several years in the library of Congress, but of late years he has been filling various positions under the District government. For several years he led various church choirs in the District. He was a prominent member of the order of Odd Fellows, holding membership in Excelsior Lodge, Mount Nebo Encampment, and the Grand Lodge and Grand Encampment. Mr. Clubb was also a prominent mason—a member of St. Johns Lodge, No. 11, and Washington Commandery, Knight Templar.
