### **Warren J. Coffin Buried**

#### **Funeral Services Held Yesterday Afternoon at the Residence**

Funeral services for Warren J. Coffin were held yesterday afternoon at the family residence, 115 4th street southeast. Mr. Coffin, who was fifty-one years old, was manager of the lunchroom of the bureau of engraving and printing, and was for eighteen years in charge of the lunchroom at the House of Representatives.

Interment was in Congressional cemetery, Masonic services being held. The pallbearers were representatives from the Knights Templar and The New Jerusalem Lodge of Masons, with two representatives from Rathbone Superior Lodge, Knights of Pythias.
