Dr. Seth Eugene Cole, 81, a dentist here for nearly 45 years, died yesterday of a heart attack at his home, 639 East Capitol street. He had been ill for several months.

Dr. Cole had lived in Washington since he was 16. As a young man he worked as a machine apprentice at the Washington Navy Yard.

He was graduated from Columbia College, now George Washington University, in 1905. His entire dental practice had been at the East Capitol street address. He continued his practice until a year ago.

Dr. Cole was born in Williston, Vt. He married Edith Mahon of Annandale, Va., in 1894. She died four years after their marriage.

Dr. Cole was a past grand master of the Harmony Lodge of the Odd Fellows. He belonged to St. Mark's Episcopal Church and was

a former member of the District Dental Society. Also, he was a member of the Washington Light Infantry, a forerunner of the National Guard.

Surviving are a son, Dr. Eugene Cole of the East Capitol street address, a general practitioner and surgeon, and a grandson, Eugene Thomas Cole of the home address.
