Former Resident, Who Succumbed in Brooklyn, Buried Here

Mrs. Camilla C. Collins, 80 years old, a resident of this city for many years, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Walter DeMontreville, Brooklyn, N.Y., Monday after an illness of four months. Private funeral services were conducted at the residence of her son, Thomas D. Collins, 4120 New Hampshire avenue this city, this afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment was in Congressional Cemetery.

Mrs. Collins, a native of Virginia, was the widow of John W. Collins. She had been living with her daughter in Brooklyn for the past 15 years.

She is survived by two sons, Albert G. Collins and Thomas D. Collins, both of this city; three daughters, Mrs. DeMontreville, Mrs. John M. McDuell of Atlantic City, and Mrs. Robert E. Doyle, sr., of Washington, also 9 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.
