Mrs. S.V. Cooksey Dead

Was Lifelong Resident of Washington--Funeral Saturday

Mrs. S.V. Cooksey, a lifelong resident and native of Washington, died at 12:50 o'clock this morning at her residence, 302 North Carolina avenue southeast. Members of her family were at her bedside.

Funeral services will be held Saturday morning at 9:30 o'clock in St. Peter's Catholic Church, of which Mrs. Cooksey was a lifelong member, and where she had been both christened and married. High mass will be celebrated by Msr. James M. O'Brien, assisted by Rev. J.L. Weidenhan and Rev. Stephen T. Morris. Burial will be made in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Cooksey was the widow of Charles E. Cooksey, also a native of Washington. Her eldest son is George R. Cooksey, private secretary to the Secretary of the Treasury. Her other children are Miss Blanche C. Cooksey, Harry B. Cooksey and C. Herman Cooksey.
