Frederick Cornwell, Ex-U.S. Employee

Frederick C. Cornwell, 77, a federal government employee for 43 years, died Thursday of pneumonia at the University Nursing Home in Wheaton.

Mr. Cornwell, who was born in the District, began his federal employment as an apprentice mechanic at the Navy Yard in 1912. At the time of his retirement in 1956, Mr. Cornwell was an administrative aide to the assistant postmaster general.

He is survived by his wife, Sue, of the home at 8811 Colesville Rd., Silver Spring, and a brother, William F. Cornwell of Edgewater, Md.
