James S.W. Cotton Dies

Funeral Services for Late Laundry Proprietor Friday Afternoon

James S.W. Cotton, laundry proprietor, died at his residence, 123 M street southeast, yesterday morning after an illness of about four months. His death was due to heart disease. He was fifty-three years old.

The body will be removed to the undertaking establishment of J. William Lee this afternoon, where funeral services will be held Friday at 3 o'clock. Rev. James D. Buhrer, pastor of the First Reformed Church, officiating. The body will be cremated late Friday afternoon.

Mr. Cotton is survived by his wife, who was formerly Miss Julia Hoffman of Baltimore, and three daughters and one son--Mrs. Laura Cotton, Misses Hazel and Julia Cotton and Harry Cotton.
