Death of a Well-Known Physician

Dr. Richard C. Croggon, a well-known physician of South Washington, died at his residence, on 7th street, between E and F, southwest, yesterday afternoon, Dr. C. was a young but highly popular physician, enjoying a very large practice. He was the youngest son of the late John Croggon, and studied medicine with Dr. Jos. Borrows. For several years he was a school trustee in the 4th district. He was a member of Dawson Lodge, Washington Chapter of Masons, Washington Commandery, Knights Templar, and Columbia Lodge of Odd Fellows.

The Evening Star, September 26, 1872

The funeral of the late Dr. Croggon took place from Ryland Chapel yesterday afternoon, and was very largely attended. The following organizations were present at the church with Donch's band, but in consequence of the heavy rain, they did not go to the cemetery: Dawson Lodge of Masons, Washington Commandery of Knights Templar, Columbia Lodge of Odd Fellows, Medical Society of the District, and the alumni of the medical department of Georgetown College. The religious services were conducted by Rev. S. Shannon, after which the services of the different orders took place, and the body was removed to the hearse, and, followed by the family, was taken to the Congressional cemetery.
