#### **Funeral Services to Be Held Thursday by Rev. Wm. M. Nevins**

Mrs. Ann E.P. Cross died this morning at the home of her son, Capt. F.E. Cross of the police department, 319 9th street southeast. Mrs. Cross was eighty-one years of age, and had been ill for several weeks. She had resided in Washington all of her life and was married in 1842 to James P. Cross. Besides Capt. Cross she is survived by five other children, Mrs. S.H. Rearick, Mrs. Inver Griffith and J.H., M.K. and Thomas E. Cross. From early childhood she was a member of Trinity M.E. Church, southeast Washington.
