## **Found Dead in Her Bed**

## Mrs. Elizabeth Crowthers Succumbs to Cerebral Hemorrhage

Mrs. Elizabeth Crowthers, seventy-three years old, was found dead in bed in her room at the house of Mrs. M.M. Whitten, 227 K street northwest, shortly before noon today. Her death, Coroner Nevitt said, resulted from a cerebral hemorrhage, death having probably occurred late yesterday afternoon.

Mrs. Crowthers had been employed as a clerk in the Post Office Department in her younger days. Little was known of her, however, at the K street house. She had rented a small hall room on the third floor about two weeks ago. Yesterday afternoon she did her washing and, it is believed, the exertion was too much for her. It is probable that her body will be taken to the morgue late this afternoon.

The police and the occupants of the K street house are trying to locate the relatives of the deceased.
