Death of Charles S. Cudlipp

Charles S. Cudlipp, the photographer, died suddenly yesterday at noon at his rooms in the St. James Hotel. He had been subject to epilepsy, and Saturday morning he fell in a fit of this character, striking his head heavily. Later in the day he was seized with another attack while lying in bed and remained unconscious until his death. Mrs. Cudlipp had returned from Europe only Friday morning. Her husband was 41 years old and had been in the photographic business here about 15 years. The funeral will be strictly private.
