Judson Cull, Title Attorney, Dead at 73

Judson T. Cull, Jr., 73, Washington title attorney, died early yesterday at his home, 5331 Chamberlin ave., Kenwood, Md., after an extended illness.

Mr. Cull, who received his law degree from Columbia College, had been a member of the District Bar for over 50 years. He had served as general counsel for the Metropolitan Building Association since 1932, succeeding his father, the late Judson T. Cull, Sr., who had been general counsel for the association since its organization in 1866.

Mr. Cull also was director of the Liberty National Bank and president of the Home Title Insurance Co., which he and his father organized in the District in 1901.

Surviving are four sisters, Mary, Virginia and Florence Cull and Ethel Cull French of Kenwood.

Private services will be held at 11 a.m. today at his home, with burial in Congressional Cemetery.
