### **Byron Dement, In Hotel Work Here 50 Years**

Byron T. Dement, 64, who worked in Washington hotels for nearly 50 years, died yesterday in Fairfax Hospital after a brief illness. He lived at 4103 W St. NW.

Mr. Dement, a native Washingtonian, was a graduate of the city's public school system. During his high school days he worked as a carrier for The Star. He entered the hotel field around 1920.

During World War II he was resident manager of the Wardman Park Hotel (now the Sheraton Park Hotel). He was employed at the Gramercy Inn Hotel at the time of his death.
