


## Godfrey F. Eckloff

### **Funeral**

Mr. Godfrey F. Eckloff, an old and respected citizen, and for many years one of our leading merchant tailors, died on the 20th instant, after a short illness at his residence, No. 267 C street, at the advanced age of 87 years. He came to this city in 1817, as a cutter for his brother, and since that time has been actively engaged at his profession. His remains were interred yesterday in the Congressional Cemetery. Rev. Dr. Finckel, of the German Lutheran Church, officiating. The pall-bearers were Col. Sampson Folsom, Col. Francis Batice, Rev. Israel Folsom, Dr. Thomas Bond, all of the Choctaw Nation of Indians and two citizens. Those Indians were intimately acquainted with the deceased and often dealt with him. Col. P.P. Pitchlynn, of the same tribe, is a son-in-law of the deceased.
