D.C. Engineer Dies

A.S. Fernald in Service of City More Than 25 Years

The engineer department of the District government lost one of its veteran workers yesterday, when Albert S. Fernald died at his home, 23 15th street southeast, following an illness of a few days.

Mr. Fernald, who had been assistant engineer in charge of asphalt street resurfacing for many years, was taken sick at the District building Friday and sank rapidly. He was fifty-five years old and had been in the municipal services for more than a quarter of a century.
