

Joseph Wilburger Fillius (8 Jan 1847 – 30 Sep 1890)

Yesterday Joseph Fillius of Anacostia, attempting to get on a cable car at the corner of 7th street and Pennsylvania avenue, fell and had his knee badly bruised and his forehead cut. He was taken to the Emergency Hospital by Officer Hinkle and Dr. Hay dressed his wounds.
