FITZPATRICK, LOUISE (nee HULL)

Painter and teacher active in Washington, DC from as early as 1892. She was an instructor in preparation and sketch at the Art Students League of Washington during the period 1892-1903, and later at the Corcoran School of Art as an instructor in portrait painting. She exhibited with the Society of Washington Artists in 1900 and was active in the Washington Water Color Club from 1899 until 1911, serving on the board of managers of the latter organization. She died in Washington in 1911. She may be the painter of an oil entitled "Evening" in the collection of the Butler Institute of America Art.
