## **Military Funeral**

The funeral of the late Frederick Hillman took place yesterday from the armory of Company A, Washington Light Infantry, of which company he was a member, and was largely attended. The services were conducted by Rev. P. Brandt, of the German Lutheran Church, and the remains--in a coffin of black walnut ornamented with heavy silver mountings and covered with the American flag and beautiful wreaths of flowers--were born by Corporals Mudd and Brashears and Privates Shay, Miller, Smith and Touhy, the pall-bearers to the hearse. Company A, with reversed arms, preceded by the marine band, escorted the funeral cortege to the Congressional cemetery, where the remains were interred.
