### **William H. Hodges Dies; In U.S. Service 53 Years**

#### **Funeral Rites for Civil War Veteran to Be Held at Residence Monday Morning**

William H. Hodges, civil war veteran and longtime government employe, died yesterday at his residence, 3218 18th street. Funeral services are to be held Monday morning at the residence. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Hodges served with Company K, 2d Regiment, New Jersey Volunteer Infantry, and later in the military railway service. For the past fifty-three years he had been connected with the quartermaster general's office at the War Department.

In the late 60s Mr. Hodges was a member of the old National baseball club in this city.

He was a member of Kit Carson Post, No. 2, G.A.R., and Columbia Conclave, No. 11, Independent Order of Heptasophs. He is survived by a daughter, Mrs. John S.M. Zimmermann, wife of the bandmaster at Soldiers' Home, and one son, Lieut. Col. William S. Hodges, District National Guard, retired.
