Father Identifies Drowned Boy's Body

River Victim Was Allen Hutchinson – Lost Life While Fishing

The body of a 9-year-old boy, drowned yesterday afternoon while fishing in the Eastern Branch near Benning was identified last night as that of Allen Hutchinson, 3203 E street southeast.

The identification was made by the boy's father, Francis Hutchinson, after the body had been at the morgue for eight hours without identification.

The boy had been fishing with two friends and is believed to have fallen into deep water at the sewer outlet of the Potomac Electric Power Co. His two companions became frightened and ran.

A colored boy witnessed the drowning and tried unsuccessfully to rescue the Hutchinson boy. The body was recovered several hours later by members of the harbor precinct.
