Miss Hyatt was a granddaughter of Christopher Clark Hyatt, for whom the town of Hyattsville, Md., was named, the family said.

She was born in Hyattsville in the house today known as the Hyatt mansion. Her father died when she was about 11 years old and the family moved to Washington

Miss Hyatt was a member of the Washington Club and St. Margaret's Church.
