Young Woman Ends Her Life With Poison

Mother of Miss Mamie Jackson Thinks Broken Love Affair Caused Act

Miss Mamie Jackson, thirty-two years old, who resided with her mother, Mrs. Davis, at 650 I street southwest, this morning took a quantity of poison and died in George Washington University Hospital about one hour later. She was in the office of Dr. W.L. Hagan, a dentist, in the Real Estate Trust building, 14th and H streets, where she was employed, when she took the poison.

Miss Jackson staggered through the hall to the door of the office of Charles M. Cuthberson, a dentist groaned, "I've taken poison," and fell to the floor unconscious. Dr. Hagan rendered first aid before the dying woman was removed to the hospital.
