H.G. Kelly, 72, Victim of Street Car Accident

Dies of Cerebral Hemorrhage, Result of Fractured Skull

Harry G. Kelly, seventy-two years old, a retired navy yard employe, died at his home, 1112 C street southeast, yesterday morning, his death resulting from cerebral hemorrhage and shock following a fracture of the skull, received when he was knocked down by a street car at East Capitol street and Tennessee avenue the afternoon of November 14. He was taken to Casualty Hospital, where he remained several days, and was taken home when his condition appeared to be improved. Later a physician was summoned. A change for the worse came and death occurred. Coroner Nevitt will hold an inquest at the morgue late this afternoon.
