G.R. Kendrick, 76, Dies Former U.S. Employee

George R. Kendrick, 76, life-long resident of Washington, and a former government employe, died yesterday after a long illness.

Mr. Kendrick worked at the Government Printing Office for many years as chief steamfitter, finally accepting a job at the Interior Department, where he remained until his retirement from active work about five years ago.
