Miss Kershaw was born in New York State in 1846, and came to Washington when a young woman to enter the Government service as a clerk in the Treasury Department. She was retired some years ago, after having served 45 years in one office of the department, that of national bank redemption agency.

As a member of the First Presbyterian Church for many years, Miss Kershaw was active in church work here, and from its inception had been a member of the board of lady managers of the Presbyterian Home. She is survived by a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Wyman of Sycamore, Ill.
