A 64-year-old Washington man died Saturday night of injuries he received in a two-car collision at New York Avenue and Bladensburg Road NE, police said.

William L. Knight, 424 East Capitol Street, was pronounced dead on arrival at Providence Hospital shortly after the 11 p.m. accident.

Knight was attempting to make a left turn at that intersection when the car he was driving was struck in the side by a car driven by Donald E. Crockett, 35, of 2617 Martin Luther King Avenue SE.

Crockett was hospitalized at Providence in fair condition yesterday. No charges have been placed against Crockett, police said, pending a hearing before the corporation counsel.
