U.S. Worker Succumbs

Samuel Krigbaum, 50, Stricken at Clarendon Trolley Station

Clarendon, Va., December 20 --

Samuel Krigbaum, 50 years old, died yesterday at his home, 109 Beach street, of heart disease and paralysis. He was a printer in the Bureau of Engraving and Printing 27 years. As he awaited a car to take him to his work he was stricken. He returned to his home and died within a half hour.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 2 p.m. from the residence. Burial will be in Columbia Gardens Cemetery.

Besides his widow, he is survived by three daughters, Mrs. William Elliott, Miss Margaret Krigbaum and Miss Virginia Krigbaum, and one son, Orlando Krigbaum.
