Carl Frank Krogmann Pilot

Carl Frank Krogmann, 69, a retired commercial and private pilot who was a longtime area resident, died Nov. 12 at Arlington Hospital after a heart attack. He lived in Arlington.

Mr. Krogmann was a native of Washington and a graduate of McKinley Technical High School and the University of Maryland. During World War II, he flew Atlantic patrols for the Royal Canadian Air Force and the U.S. Coast Guard.
