Cazenove G. Lee, Jr., Dies; Founder of Virginia Society

Cazenove G. Lee, jr., 63, founder of the Society of the Lees of Virginia, died yesterday at his home, 3542 Newark street, N.W., after an illness of several months.

Mr. Lee was born in Washington, the son of the late Cazenove G. and Marguerite du Pont Lee. He was educated at Cornell University as an engineer. After employment with the du Pont company until 1920, he retired from business and devoted his time to genealogical and historic research.

He was a member of Sigma Phi Society.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Dorothy V. Lee; a daughter, Mrs. Walter B. Mahony, jr., of Scarborough, N.Y.; two sons, Lt. L. Vandegrift Lee, U.S.N.R., and Lt. Richard H. Lee, A.U.S.; a brother, Maurice du Pont Lee of Wilmington, Del., and two grandchildren.
