### **Died in New Jersey**

Mrs. Lindsay, the widow of the late Alexander Lindsay, for many years before the war a teacher in our public schools, and for some time a clerk in the Treasury department, died at East Orange, N.J., on Wednesday night, of typhoid fever. Her remains, accompanied by her sons and other relatives, arrived this morning at the B & P depot, and at 10 o'clock, after brief services in the depot, were taken to the Congressional cemetery and buried. Mrs. Lindsay, with her sons after the death of her husband, removed first to Brooklyn, N.Y., and for the past 12 or 15 years had resided there and in East Orange.
